Here are a few reminders from the **HEALTH OFFICE** for the new school year ~

ILLNESS/ATTENDANCE:

Children need to be healthy to learn. For your child's comfort and the health of other students at school, please keep your child home if he/she has any of the following:

- Fever higher than 100 degrees
(Students should be fever free for 24 hours before returning to school)
- Vomiting / diarrhea or fever within the last 24 hours
- Frequent, uncontrollable cough
- Undiagnosed rash

ALSO REMEMBER:

- Children in Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten usually need 10 – 12 hours of sleep each night. Establish a routine bedtime.
- Give your child a variety of healthy foods each day. Avoid junk foods.
- Listen to the weather report each morning and choose appropriate outdoor clothing. Dress your child in layers if there's a possibility that the weather will change.
- Choose clothing that's simple, safe, sturdy and comfortable. No drawstrings or ties! Label garments. Boots should be large enough to be put on without help.

MEDICATIONS:

As the school nurse I **CANNOT** administer any medications without an order from your child's physician **AND** permission from you as per New York State guidelines. This includes over the counter medications (aspirin, cold medication, etc.) Students **CANNOT** carry medication on them unless there is a doctor's order in the nurse's office to do so. Please let me know if your child needs to take medication in school so I can get the appropriate forms to you.
