

**NOTICE OF SPECIAL SCHOOL DISTRICT
MEETING OF THE VOTERS OF THE
WILLSBORO CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT**

THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE Willsboro Central School District **HEREBY GIVES NOTICE** that pursuant to a Resolution adopted by the Board of Education of the District on August 20, 2026, a special meeting of the qualified voters of said Willsboro Central School District in the County of Essex, State of New York, will be held in the Willsboro Central School District Willsboro Central School, 29 School Lane, Willsboro, New York 12996 on October 6, 2026 from 12:00 P.M. to 8:00 P.M. prevailing time, for the purpose of voting upon the following proposition:

PROPOSITION

Shall the Board of Education undertake a project consisting of the construction, reconstruction, renovation, rehabilitation and improvement of the Willsboro Central School (High/Middle/Elementary), including but not limited to paving and site improvements, sidewalks and curbing, playground and outdoor education improvements, roofing reconstruction, flashing and soffit improvements, flooring refinishing, gymnasium upgrades, scoreboards, bleachers and windows, auditorium lighting and audio system improvements, security and safety improvements, door and hardware replacement, re-keying and re-coring, HVAC and ventilation improvements, building automation and control system improvements, generator and electrical infrastructure improvements, together with original furnishings, fixtures, equipment, machinery, apparatus, site work, ancillary and incidental improvements, architectural and engineering costs and all other necessary costs incidental thereto at a total estimated cost not to exceed \$10,300,000 and obtain the necessary funds by the levy of a tax in the amount of \$10,300,000 upon the taxable property of the District to be collected in annual installments in the years and in the amounts as the Board of Education shall determine and in anticipation of such tax bonds and notes of the District are hereby authorized to be issued at one time, or from time to time, in the principal amount not to exceed \$10,300,000, and a tax is hereby voted to pay the interest on said obligations when due.

NOTICE IS GIVEN that voting upon the foregoing Proposition will be by paper ballot or voting machine.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that qualified voters may obtain applications for an absentee ballot or early voting ballot from the office of the Clerk of the District. Completed applications for an absentee ballot or early voting ballot must be received by the District Clerk of the District no later than 4:00 P.M. prevailing time, on October 5, 2026 and must be received no later than 4:00 P.M. prevailing time, on September 29, 2026 if the absentee ballot or early voting ballot to be mailed to the voter. Completed applications received after 4:00 P.M. on September 28, 2026, will require the voter to personally appear at the Office of the Clerk of the District to receive an absentee ballot or early voting ballot. A listing of all persons to whom an absentee ballot or early voting ballot is issued will be available for inspection by any qualified voter in the Office of the Clerk of the District between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 4:00 P.M. during each of the five (5) business days prior to the election.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that military ballots may be applied for by qualified voters by requesting an application from the District Clerk at (518) 963-4456 ext. 201 or bpierce@willsborocsd.org. Completed applications for military ballots must be received by the District Clerk no later than 4:00 P.M. on September 10, 2026. In a request for a military ballot application or ballot, the military voter may indicate their preference for receiving the application or ballot by mail, facsimile transmission or electronic mail.
